## Around The Neighborhood . . .

- 1.) **Annual Meeting** – The 2026 Woods of Glenmary annual meeting will be at 6:30 pm on Thursday April 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Kentucky Realty office at 3330 Pinecroft Drive. Please try to attend as there will be an election for Board members for five sections. If you cannot attend the meeting, please send your proxy to Ben at Kentucky Realty or a member of the Board.
- 2.) **Road Paving** – Starting on or after Thursday 3/26/26 Broadwood Drive will be paved as weather permits. Metro Louisville will be adding disabled curb ramps at the intersections at the sidewalk along Broadwood Drive and afterward the road will be paved. Traffic will still be able to come and go but we need to be mindful to slow down when workers are present. Also, you may want to leave a few minutes early in case there are traffic delays.
- 3.) **Newspaper Box Notice** – With the weather getting warmer please remember to look before reaching into your newspaper box. Last year one of our residents was stung by a wasp when they reached into their newspaper box. If you have insect activity in your newspaper box a potential solution is placing a dryer sheet in the box to repel the insects. Also, if you remove a nest, please be certain it is completely removed to reduce the chances of the insects returning.
- 4.) **Neighborhood Watch** – Last November a couple of our residents had their cars robbed overnight. The cars were left unlocked. We have not heard of any more instances of cars being robbed. We encourage anyone leaving your car outside of your garage to be certain to lock your car. LMPD suggests that it is always a good idea to keep the doors to your home and your car locked, even if you are home.
- 5.) **A & L Forms** – Please remember to submit an A & L form to the Board for pre-approval of any outside project.
- 6.) **Trash Can Reminder**- If possible, trash cans should be placed together on either side of the driveway or in the middle of the driveway.

## Just as a reminder . . .

- 1.) **Proof of Homeowners Insurance** – Is required yearly by our Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CCR's) and should be sent to Ben Adams at Kentucky

Realty. The easiest way to do this is to call your insurance agent and have him/her fax the document to Ben at Kentucky Realty (502-473-7269) or email the document to Ben at [ben@kentuckyrealty.net](mailto:ben@kentuckyrealty.net).

- 2.) **Type of Homeowners Insurance** - Our patio homes are considered a type of single-family home and require an HO3 policy, they not considered condominiums which require an HO6 policy.
- 3.) **Website** – [www.woodsofglenmary.org](http://www.woodsofglenmary.org). On our website, you can find HOA Documents (like the CCR's, By-Laws and Amendments), WOG Board of Director's Meeting Minutes, Annual Meeting Minutes, and Newsletters. The website is a great resource for information, A&L forms, and other documents.
- 4.) **Reach Alert Notices** – By signing up for these notices, you will receive prompt reminders and notices about things going on in the Woods of Glenmary. It's free, it's easy and you can sign up to receive text messages, emails, or both. Go to [www.reachalert.com](http://www.reachalert.com) or call 877-307-9313 to sign up.
- 5.) **Maintenance Fees** – If you are new to the neighborhood, please make sure you contact Kentucky Realty (502-473-0003) to get your HOA Maintenance Fee Account set up. Neither the real estate agent nor the closing attorney takes care of this AND the maintenance fee is NOT included in your mortgage payment.

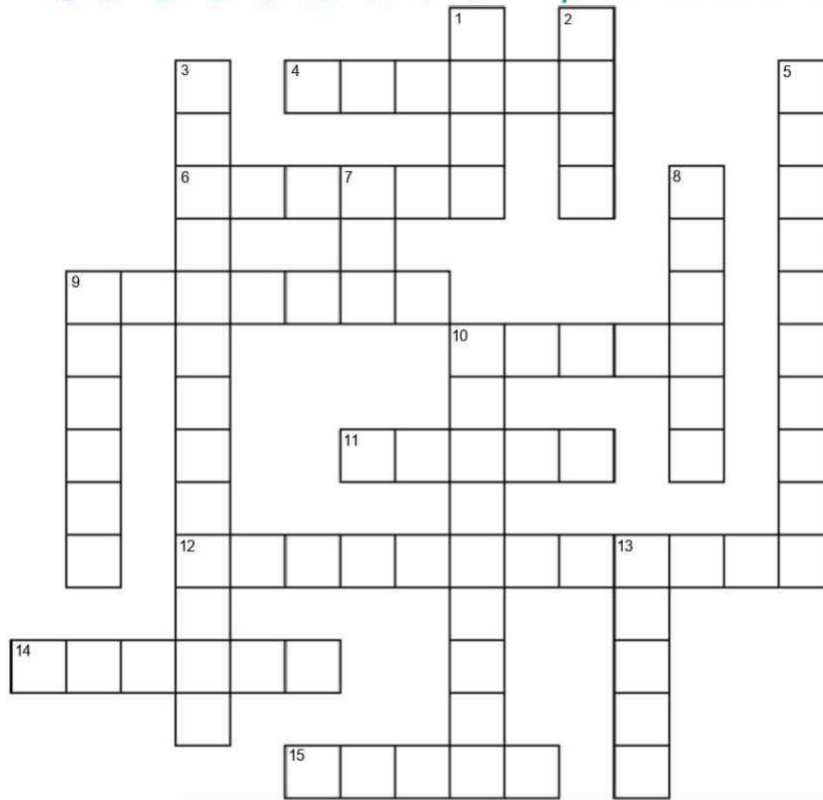
