Around The Neighborhood . . .

- 1.) **Road Work** – The intersection of Hillock Drive and Old Bardstown Road will be closed starting on Monday 07/06/26 for roadwork.
- 2.) **Neighborhood Watch** – We have not had any incidents reported recently. We do encourage residents to remain vigilant in locking your doors, locking your car when left outside and keeping garage doors closed. Also, if possible, please do not place checks in the mail (especially overnight) and if you see a strange car parked outside do not approach it. If you are concerned about the car, please call the police and report it.
- 3.) **Solicitation** – The Woods of Glenmary has a no solicitation policy. No one should come to your door unannounced offering services or selling products. If you do hire someone to complete work for you, please inform them of this policy. Recently a young man was going house to house offering window cleaning services stating they were cleaning windows for one of our residents. If a solicitor comes to your home unannounced you do not need to answer the door or speak with them, and we encourage you not to invite them into your home.
- 4.) **A & L Forms** – Please remember to submit an A & L form to the Board for pre-approval of any outside project.

Just as a reminder . . .

- 1.) **Proof of Homeowners Insurance** – Is required yearly by our Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CCR's) and should be sent to Ben Adams at Kentucky Realty. The easiest way to do this is to call your insurance agent and have him/her fax the document to Ben at Kentucky Realty (502-473-7269) or email the document to Ben at ben@kentuckyrealty.net.
- 2.) **Type of Homeowners Insurance** - Our patio homes are considered a type of single-family home and require an HO3 policy, they not considered condominiums which require an HO6 policy.
- 3.) **Website** – www.woodsoglenmary.org. On our website, you can find HOA Documents (like the CCR's, By-Laws and Amendments), WOG Board of Director's Meeting Minutes, Annual Meeting Minutes, and Newsletters. The website is a great resource for information, A&L forms, and other documents.

- 4.) **Reach Alert Notices** – By signing up for these notices, you will receive prompt reminders and notices about things going on in the Woods of Glenmary. It's free, it's easy and you can sign up to receive text messages, emails, or both. Go to www.reachalert.com or call 877-307-9313 to sign up.
- 5.) **Maintenance Fees** – If you are new to the neighborhood, please make sure you contact Kentucky Realty (502-473-0003) to get your HOA Maintenance Fee Account set up. Neither the real estate agent nor the closing attorney takes care of this AND the maintenance fee is NOT included in your mortgage payment.

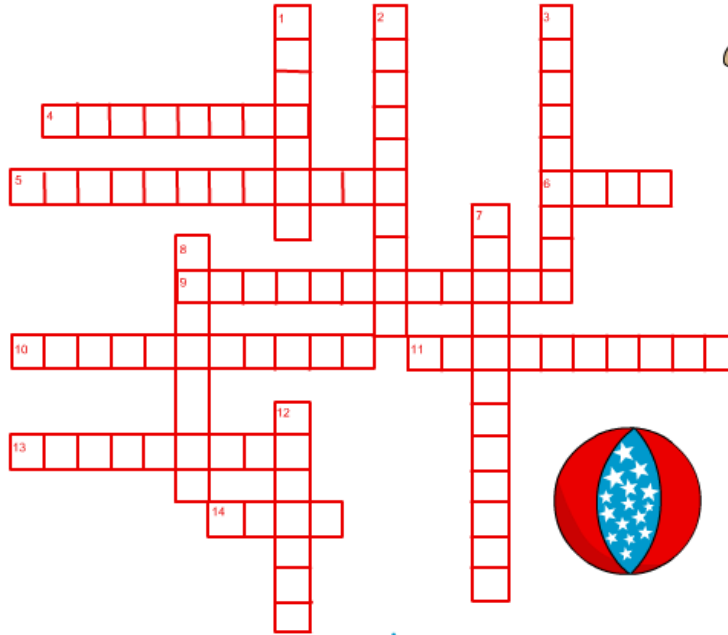
